Dear Sir:

- Hill Country Cellars, Inc., a winery and vineyard operation located on the North side of U.S. 183 in Cedar Park, Texas, by and through its President, Fred H. Thomas, does hereby request that the above referenced Notice of proposed rulemaking be amended as follows:
- 9.136 (c)(1): The beginning point is the intersection of Interstate Highway 35 and State Highway 29 to the north of Austin, Texas, on the Georgetown, Texas, U.S.G.S. map;
- 9.136 (c)(2) From the beginning point, the boundary follows State Highway 29 in a west northwesterly direction on the Leander NE, U.S.G.S. map to the intersection with U.S. Highway 183 in Seward Junction, on the Leander NE U.S.G.S. map;
- 9.136 (c)(3) The boundary then follows U.S. Highway 183 in a northwesterly direction through the Liberty Hill U.S.G.S. and across the northeast corner of the LLano, Texas, U.S.G.S. map, to the intersection with State Highway 190 in Lometa, on the Brownwood, Texas, U.S.G.S. map;
- [9.136 (c)(4) The boundary then follows State Highway 190...( As previously provided in sections 9.136 (c) (3)...(9) then:]
- 9.136 (c)(11) The boundary then follows Interstate 35 in a northeasterly direction across the San Antonio map and then across the northwest corner of the Sequin, Texas, U.S.G.S. map, across the Austin U.S.G.S. map, Austin East U.S.G.S. map, Pflugerville West U.S.G.S. map, Round Rock, Texas, U.S.G.S. map and back to the beginning point at the intersection with State Highway 29, north of Austin, on the Georgetown, Texas, U.S.G.S. map.

In support of this request for amendment I offer the following:

1. At the time that the original proposal was submitted by Mr. Hugo Edwin Auler, Hill Country Cellars was in the planning stages and was unknown to the group requesting the viticultural designation. Subsequently, when Mr. Auler became aware of Hill Country Cellars winery and vineyard, recognizing the slight ambiguity of the northern boundary, he contacted me to suggest that Hill Country Cellars request Maling Address:

an amendment so that Hill Country Cellars, the only now known winery or vineyard lying directly on a proposed boundary could be included within the proposed designated viticultural area. Mr. Auler suggested the change in boundary lines which I have submitted as an amendment and it is my belief that he and others within the proposed area fully support this change in boundary.

- 2. Enclosed as Exhibits 1-4, items demonstrating that the area which would now be included in the proposed viticultural area is locally and/or nationally known as referring to the area specified as Texas Hill Country are:
- (Ex 1.) Pages from the telephone books of Cedar Park, Leander, Round Rock, and Georgetown indicating the large number of businesses within these communities, previously excluded, that use Hill Country as part of their business name.
- (Ex 2.) A recent copy of the local Cedar Park based newspaper "The Hill Country News."
- (Ex. 3) Texas Hill Country Wine & Food Festival Program which includes Hill Country Cellars as one of the Host wineries.
- (Ex. 4&5) Materials from the Cedar Park Chamber of Commerce and Economic Development Committee that discuss the history of the area, its geography and geology, together with pertinent information as to elevation, climate and annual rainfall characteristics.
- 3. Letter from Christopher P. Davies, Ph.D., Associate Professor, Geography Department, University of Texas at Austin (Exhibit 6), Indicating his conclusion that Interstate Highway 35 and State Highway 29 would be a more accurate boundary than those previously submitted. He reached this conclusion after an extensive review of the geography, geology, climate and soils information available from public sources. In addition to Dr. Davies letter, Mr. Brian Arabie of Arabie Inc., a consulting Geologist, and Ms. Diane Hyatt, a Geologist at the State Land Office have both indicated that the area which I have included is of the same general geology as that of nearby areas previously included in the area and generally lies west of the Balcones Fault Zone which was used to identify, geologically, the eastern boundary of the Texas Hill Country Appellation. Both Geologists have agreed to submit letters if necessary. I have included as Exhibit 7., a copy of "Geological Atlas of Texas, Austin sheet," published by the Bureau of Economic Geology which clearly demonstrates these facts.
- 4. Topographical information is similar to the other areas within the proposed area with elevations ranging between 717-1300 feet above sea level (See Ex. 4). Climate is similar to other areas within the proposed area: Average temperatures at Cedar Park: Annual 65 F., January 37 F., July 90 F., Average days sunshine: 300. Average rainfall 36" (See Exhibit 5). As demonstrated by the soils analysis conducted by the Texas Agricultural Extension Service of Texas A&M University soils at Hill Country Cellars are similar to those within the proposed area and dissimilar to those east of Interstate 35 and north of State Highway 29 (Refer to Letter of Dr. Davies). Soils east of Interstate 35 are blackland soils, live oaks are rarely found east

of the Interstate and are widely found within the proposed area as amended.

Also enclosed as Exhibit 8 are copies of the additional U.S.G.S. maps covering the proposed amended boundary lines together with a small map of the entire area as originally presented and as revised.

I believe the information that I have submitted should demonstrate that the amendment is justified. If necessary however, I will supplement with additional information. In addition, if the information provided is determined to be insufficient I would request both an extension of time to supplement and request the opportunity to comment orally at a public hearing on the proposed regulation.





Dear Mr. Thomas:

In regard to the boundary lines presently under consideration for the demarcation of the geological zone for the wine-producing area known as the "Appellation of Origin" in the Texas Hill Country, it is my opinion that the northeastern edge is more sensibly represented by IH-35 on the east and Highway 29 (Georgetown) on the north, than as presently constituted.

This opinion is based on an extensive survey of the climate, soils, vegetation, and geomorphology of Austin and its surrounds conducted by the Bureau of Economic Geology at The University of Texas at Austin (1975), and studies conducted by Terry G. Jordan, Walter Prescott Webb Professor of Geography, also at The University of Texas at Austin (see Terry G. Jordan, "The Texas Appalachia," Annals of the Association of American Geographers, LX (Sept., 1970), 409-427; also Terry G. Jordan, et al, Texas: A Geography (Boulder, Colo., 1984).

By necessity, a boundary requires a linear demarcation. However, a boundary is really perceived as a zone of considerable width and cultural content as exemplified by the broad swathe of the US-Mexico border area. In this light, I believe the geographical zone to be designated as the "Appellation of Origin" in the Texas Hill Country is best represented, based on the physical geography of the area, by an eastern demarcation that parallels IH-35 and a northern demarcation of Highway 29 (Georgetown) than as presently so devised.
