8. CHARGE

VIOLATIONS: The proponent allegedly failed to pay some federal excise tax liability in violation of 26 U.S.C. §5001, §5002, §5005, §5006, §6601, §6651, §6652 for some periods between July 1, 2015 and December 31, 2017.

BUSINESS IN WHICH ENGAGED:

The proponent is a duly qualified bonded Distilled Spirits Plant operator.

DATE OR PERIOD AND LOCATION OF VIOLATIONS:

The alleged violations occurred for some of the periods between July 1, 2015 to December 31, 2017 at the proponent's premises located at 33 35th St STE 6A, Brooklyn, NY 11232.

AMOUNT AND TERMS OF OFFER:

The proponent has submitted an offer of \$53,668.75 in compromise of tax liability incurred under the Internal Revenue Code. The terms of the offer are the following: an initial payment of \$20,000; and the remaining balance to be paid by 6/30/2019.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Director, National Revenue Center, recommends acceptance of the offer. The proponent listed doubt as to collectibility and provided supporting financial documentation. The acceptance of the Offer-In-Compromise, as submitted, is warranted.
