Purpose

Export Certificates

We assist industry members seeking to export their products by providing export certificates, or documents, that are often required by foreign governments in order for U.S. alcohol beverage products to be imported into a foreign market.

TTB provides export certificates as a service.



How to obtain a TTB permit to export

If you want to obtain an export certificate from TTB, you must have a TTB permit, registry or brewer's notice number. In order to obtain a TTB permit, registry or brewer's notice number please review this website: <u>https://www.ttb.gov/ponl/permits-online.shtml</u>.

If you do not see the address you are looking for you will need to update your address in <u>PONL</u>.

You will then select the type of Certificate you want for this export. (i.e., Certificate of Authenticity, Free Sale, Health, Manufacturing Process, Sanitation, Bottling, Sanitary, Origin, Age, and Origin and Age)

Next, you will select the TTB permit, registry, or brewer's notice number for the exporter. Once selected, the name of the Company and their address should auto populate from Permits Online (PONL). If the address is not correct, you will need to update it in PONL.



Once you have entered the exporter information, you will need to provide all the information for the foreign importer.
